3, 5 OR 8-DAY SILENT IGNATIAN DIRECTED RETREAT

Friday evening, June 4 - Saturday, June 12 we will offer individually directed silent retreats following the dynamics of the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius on our 380-acre campus in Mobile.

Participants may register for either 3, 5 or 8 full days of retreat. The 8-day retreat begins with a short orientation on Friday, June 4, at 7:30 p.m., and ends after lunch on Saturday, June 12. The 8-day retreatants will begin their first full retreat day on June 5. The 5- and 3-day retreats may be taken for any 5 or 3 consecutive days during this time period; retreatants should arrive for the orientation session on the previous evening, at 7:30 p.m. Room and board included in the cost.
